## Referendum Question

On November 6, 2007, election day, voters in the seven townships which comprise Unionville-Chadds Ford School District will be asked to decide a referendum question authorizing the district to borrow no more than 62.5 million dollars to complete renovations and additions to Unionville High School. Because of Act 1 of 2006, this will be the first referendum of this type for school districts in Pennsylvania.

### The Question:

*Shall debt of Unionville-Chadds Ford School District, Chester and Delaware Counties, Pennsylvania, be authorized to be incurred as debt approved by the electors in the sum of up to Sixty-Two Million, Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$62,500,000) for the purpose of renovation and addition to Unionville High School?*

The Board of School Directors has determined through months of study with professional insight that Unionville High School has a number of issues that need to be addressed. A summary of the major issues (each of which is addressed fully on the website) are:

- \* *Inadequate classroom space due to rising enrollment;*
- \* *Diminished student safety and security;*
- \* *Inadequacies in design due to building age;*
- \* *Inadequate site access and parking.*

The decision to move forward with this project is yours, through your vote on November 6. Your Committee people recommend that you **VOTE YES** on this question.
